1. Introduction

Carclew encourages participation and excellence in the arts through a range of scholarships, mentorships, grant and funding programs. The June S. Tanner Memorial Scholarship is offered by Carclew in conjunction with the Independent Arts Foundation and the Italia-Australia Association.

The June S. Tanner Memorial Scholarship supports a South Australian artist working in any art form (aged 26 and under) to further develop their practice through a professional development program in Italy.

Professional development may include short courses, studio residencies, internships or mentorships.

The value of the June S. Tanner Memorial Scholarship is \$4000.

2. Eligibility

2.1 Applicants must be 26 years of age or under at the application closing date.

2.2 Carclew invests in activity that will benefit young South Australian artists or improve youth arts opportunities in South Australia. Preferred applicants will therefore be:

- an Australian citizen or have permanent resident status in Australia; and
- able to strongly articulate their relationship and commitment to the arts and cultural industries in South Australia.

2.3 Applicants must be able to demonstrate their commitment to developing their artistic practice.

2.4 The June S. Tanner Memorial Scholarship will not support:

- The purchase of equipment or expenditure for capital items
- Project based activity
- Completion of a course of study already commenced at the time of application.

3. Assessment Criteria

3.1 Has the applicant demonstrated outstanding motivation, talent and potential in their art form or practice?

3.2 Does the proposal demonstrate that it will develop the skills of the applicant?

3.3 Has the applicant sufficiently articulated their relationship and commitment to the arts and cultural industries in South Australia?

3.4 If professional development is to be provided by an organisation or individual is there evidence of this support and the capacity for the applicant to achieve their stated aims?

3.5 Is the budget proposed for the activity realistic with reference to the awarded amount?

4. Compulsory Support Material

Your application must include:

- Links to or USB containing current examples of your work.
- Artistic curriculum vitae.
- Confirmation of acceptance into short course, mentorship, internship etc.
- Two written references from people who are prepared to provide confidential information in relation to your application. (One referee must be able to provide specialist advice on your work as a practitioner).

Where possible please provide a link to digital versions of your support material. Maximum size of email should be 5MB. If your files exceed 5MB please provide link/URL to view online.
