## **Young artist appointed as Carclew's Gallery Curator**

Carclew Youth Arts' recently appointed Foyer Gallery Curator has installed her first of eight exhibitions at Carclew for her 2012 residency.

Adele Sliuzas, 25 of Wayville, will curate eight exhibitions featuring the work of South Australian emerging artists 26 and under.

Now showing is *Get Hurt: Poster and Video Art from Adelaide's Music Scene* featuring works by Harry Freeman, Dan Heath and Lise van Konkelenberg.

Adele said "Get Hurt features work that sits on the margin of music and art. The exhibition rests on the dynamic between pop culture, visual culture and music culture; a creative intensity that is visual and aural."

Carclew's residency program has also seen the appointment of two local emerging artists Andrew Humphreys (22, Morphett Vale) and Ruby Chew (23, Prospect) as artists in residence. Both artists have already taken up their studio spaces in the former stables at Carclew House.

Adele's final exhibition will feature the work of both Ruby and Andrew, the perfect fusion marking the completion of their residency.

"The final exhibition opening night will also incorporate an open studio so the public can visit the spaces that Ruby and Andrew have used to develop their artform over the year," added Adele.

The 2012 exhibition program will include three opening night events. Carclew invites visual arts enthusiasts to take advantage of the chance to hear about Adele's curatorial process and meet the exceptional young artists featured in the exhibitions.
