***Technicolour Dreaming*: atmospheric depictions of real and imagined worlds**

Carclew emerging curator Caitlin Eyre presents ***Technicolour Dreaming***, an exhibition showing in the **Carclew Foyer Gallery** during **October and November 2014**.

Technicolour Dreaming features a collection of 14 works that depict highly atmospheric and dreamlike interpretations of both real and imagined worlds.

The artist, Amy McNamara (24, Glengowrie), is an emerging designer and illustrator who graduated from the University of South Australia in 2012, holding her first solo exhibition earlier this year.

“Amy works across a number of mediums but especially enjoys using watercolour inks, acrylics and coloured pencils,” said Caitlin (24, Balhannah).

“This series combines a bright colour palette, ornate patterns and a delicate painting style to portray the colourful worlds that inspire Amy and engulf her works in an infectious aura of joy and delight.”

Worlds of magic and superpowers depicted in television shows and novels that Amy fondly remembers from her childhood, also inspire her works today.

Her friends even finding themselves referenced in her work.

“Although this body of work carries different themes, their connection is Amy’s love for watercolour inks, vivid colours and bold contrasting patterns.”

Technicolour Dreaming is now showing in the Carclew Foyer Gallery until 11 November.

Carclew’s Foyer Gallery Curator program profiles the work of South Australia’s young and early career visual artists while providing a space for emerging curators to gain experience in artwork selection, coordination and delivery of exhibitions.
