## **Carclew gives SA schools funding for arts residencies**

Carclew Youth Arts have provided five South Australian schools with a share of \$13,000 in funding for artistic residencies in 2013 through its *Artists in Schools* program.

The residencies will take place during the first half of 2013 as a result of the strong partnership between Carclew and the Department for Education and Child Development.

Carclew's *Artists in Schools* is a long-running program, established to encourage student participation in arts projects and develop appreciation of the arts through creative interaction with a highly skilled professional arts practitioner.

*Artists in Schools* provides a vehicle for partnerships to be developed between schools, communities and artists, while achieving a creative project outcome. It has granted funding to more than 460 South Australian schools and engaged in excess of 100,000 students for more than 30 years.

"*Artists in Schools* is one of our flagship programs that provide funding for artist residencies in schools," said Tricia Walton, Carclew Chief Executive.

"Carclew's *Artists in Schools* successfully supports teachers in their delivery of the arts curriculum while engaging students in vibrant artistic projects."

**Allenby Gardens Primary School** with artist Bridgette Minuzzo (visual art/film)  
**Adelaide Secondary School of English** with artist Jade Erlandsen (dance)  
**William Light R-12 School** with artist Alirio Zavarce (theatre)  
**Trinity College** with artist Fran Callen (visual art/drawing)

Artists in Schools will reach over 390 students during Terms 1 and 2, 2013.
