Explore Arts at Carclew

Aspiring young artists of all artforms will have the chance to discover a range of artistic experiences over the October school holidays as part of **Explore Arts**, a program of workshops presented by Carclew.

Explore Arts is offering a range of one- and two-day workshops for young people aged 5-15.

Workshops will take place 9am-5pm daily, from **Tuesday 30 September to Friday 10 October**, accommodating early drop-off and late pick-up.

"Carclew is again presenting a diverse program of high-quality artistic workshops to encourage and inspire young creative minds," said Lilla Berry, Carclew's Community Project Officer.

Featured in the October program is a vibrant and musical one-day workshop **Musical Lantern Parade** with artist Sally Heinrich.

"Sally will teach children about the history of musical lantern parades before they create and decorate colourful lanterns, rattle drums and finger cymbals in preparation for a performance," said Lilla.

Limited places remain available in other workshops exploring printmaking; circus skills and the art of juggling; and character development through illustration.

"Explore Arts workshops are delivered by professional artists who provide all children with an inspiring learning and creative experience," said Lilla.

"Limited places are available in workshops, so I suggest booking as soon as possible to avoid missing out."
