Unconquered Spirit: an exhibition exploring connections with the natural world

Carclew emerging curator Craig Middleton presents his first exhibition ***Unconquered Spirit*** in the Carclew Foyer Gallery during June.

Unconquered Spirit showcases two impressive bodies of work by **emerging artist Samantha Webb** (26, Flagstaff Hill), and opens this Saturday 31 May.

Craig (25, Aberfoyle Park), one of two Carclew Foyer Gallery Curators said, "Samantha's work explores her spiritual connection to nature, stemming from her nomadic perspective of life."

Natural animal fibres and plant based dyes feature throughout her work, creating a natural, earthy palette across a range of mediums.

From illustration and portraiture to wood works, the themes of storytelling and the environment provide a strong tie between the two bodies of work.

"Samantha's desire to wander, walk and travel is deeply connected to her need to collect, gather and create; the essence of her practice," said Craig.

***Unconquered Spirit* opens Saturday 31 May, 6:30 – 9pm** and will be **showing until 2 July** in the **Carclew Foyer Gallery**.

Carclew's Foyer Gallery Curator program profiles the work of South Australia's young and early career visual artists while providing a space for emerging curators to gain experience in artwork selection, coordination and delivery of exhibitions.
