Explore Arts at Carclew

Aspiring young artists of all artforms will have the chance to discover a range of artistic experiences over the April school holidays as part of **Explore Arts**, a program of workshops presented by Carclew.

Explore Arts is offering a range of one-, two- and three-day workshops for young people aged 5-15.

Workshops will take place 9am-5pm daily, from **Monday 14 to Thursday 24 April**, accommodating early drop-off and late pick-up.

Featured in the April program are two three-day workshop series with artist James Parker.
