



## ARTISTIC WORKSHOPS FOR SOUTHERN SUBURBS

Hip-hop, break dancing, circus, theatre, street art, set design and audio/visual projection are just some of the workshops on offer as part of **Urban Culture Project** – a multi-arts workshop and performance event being held in the southern suburbs in 2012.

Presented by *ExpressWay Arts* – a pilot project of Carclew Youth Arts – **Urban Culture Project** is designed to give young arts enthusiasts from the southern suburbs an opportunity to work with professional artists to develop their craft.

As part of the Project, artists will work with local young people aged 10 – 25 to devise inventive ways to bring awareness of culture and allow young people to experience themselves as creators of, as well as participants in, 'culture'.

Workshops will be held during **April, July and September/October 2012 school holidays** and with additional street art workshops to be held throughout the year. The Project will culminate in an outdoor visual and physical theatre spectacular for the community to enjoy.

Katrina Lazaroff, *ExpressWay Arts*' creative producer, said "**Urban Culture Project** explores the evolving nature of 'culture' and how it informs and is informed by community interactions and activities."

"**Urban Culture Project** provides artistic experiences for communities to collaborate and access hands-on experience in working with innovative arts processes and professionals," added Katrina.

*ExpressWay Arts*, a pilot project of Carclew Youth Arts, opens creative opportunities for young people by highlighting career pathways for young South Australian performers and by giving children increased access to the performing arts and other art forms.
