

## Capacity Building Grants – Organisations (FAQ)

### Who can apply?

South Australian organisations working with or for young people in the arts.

### What is capacity building?

Capacity building is about strengthening how your organisation works, not delivering a specific project.

### What can we apply for?

Activities that build organisation's capability, such as:

- Strategic planning
- Governance or leadership development
- Systems, tools, or infrastructure
- Workforce or skills development

### Can this include training or professional development?

Yes – if it strengthens your organisation's ability to deliver into the future.

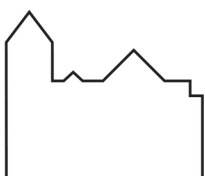
### What won't be funded?

- One-off creative projects (apply under Project & Development instead)
- Core operational costs not linked to development

### What are you looking for?

We're looking at:

- A clear need or challenge
- How the activity will strengthen your organisation
- The longer-term benefit (what changes as a result?)
- A realistic and achievable plan



**Do we need confirmed partners or venues?**

Not always, but it helps to show you have thought through delivery.

**Do we need to show long-term impact?**

Yes – this fund is about **lasting change**, not short-term activity.

**Can small organisations apply?**

Yes. This program is designed to support organisations at different stages including those still developing.

**Can we work with external consultants or partners?**

Yes. You can engage external expertise where needed.

**What does success look like?**

Success might include:

- Stronger governance or leadership
- Clearer direction or strategy
- Improved systems or processes
- Increased sustainability

**Can we apply for ongoing operational funding?**

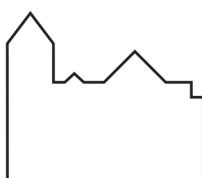
No. This program supports specific projects or development activity, not core operations.

**Can we apply if we've received Carclew funding before?**

Yes, if previous funding has been completed and acquitted

**If successful, when will we get the funding?**

Upon notification, successful applicants will be sent paperwork and instructions for payment.



**If we receive create SA funding, are we eligible?**

Yes, but its dependent upon the percentage of your recurrent annual funding and it contributes to annual income.

**What does 'limited access' mean?**

If your organisation receives multi-year recurrent funding that is less than 30% of their total income.

**Can I apply more than once in a category?**

Yes, you can apply for both Project & Development and Capacity Building grants.

**When should I expect to be notified of the outcome of my application?**

Applicants will be notified within 8 weeks of the closing date

**If I am successful, when will I get the funding?**

Upon notification, successful applicants will be sent paperwork and instructions for payment

**How long do I have to complete the activity?**

Supported activities must last no longer than one year from the proposed start date.
