Our Teacher Professional Learning is offered a number of times a year, focusing on a different specific art form, methodology or theme.

Our Teacher Professional Learning workshops network and connect educators and professional teaching artists, broadening teachers' processes and arts literacy. The workshops improve teacher understanding and knowledge for working in and through the arts while bringing together a community of educators from diverse learning environments in-person and online.

### Delivery Model

**Workshop Structure:** one-off shortform workshop.

**Delivery Location:** in-person, at Carclew, Kaurua Country, 11 Jeffcott Street, North Adelaide and/or online.

**Year Level:** the workshop content can be tailored to meet the interest of the teachers in attendance.
