

Project & Development Grants – Organisations (FAQ)

Who can apply?

Organisations based in South Australia delivering work with or for children and young people (26 and under).

What kind of projects are supported?

Projects or programs that:

- Deliver creative outcomes for young people
- Support participation, access, or pathways
- Engage artists and creative practitioners

Can we apply for a one-off project?

Yes. Funding can support a single activity, program, or development phase.

Can funding be used for artist fees?

Yes. Paying artists fairly is encouraged and expected.

What are you assessing?

We're looking at:

- Artistic quality and strength of the idea
- Benefit to young people
- Feasibility (can you deliver it well?)
- The experience and capability of your team

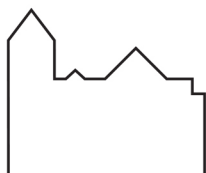
Do we need confirmed partners or venues?

Not always, but it helps to show you have thought through delivery.

Can we apply if we're a small or emerging organisation?

Yes. This program is open to small-to-medium organisations, including those still growing.

What costs can be covered?



Eligible costs may include:

- Artist fees
- Materials and production
- Travel
- Delivery costs

Can we apply for ongoing operational funding?

No. This program supports specific projects or development activity, not core operations.

Can we apply if we've received Carclew funding before?

Yes, if previous funding has been completed and acquitted.
